English Language Arts


In reading we are focused on informational texts that teach about weather and natural disasters. Students will practice summarizing what they've learned to write their own informational essays.

Science and Social Studies



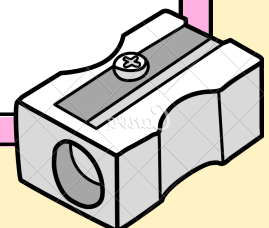
In Science, we are learning about the ways meteorologists predict weather as well as comparing different climates around the world.

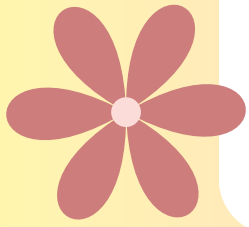
In Social Studies, we will begin studying Asian continents to present at the EFGA World Fair in May.

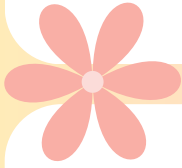

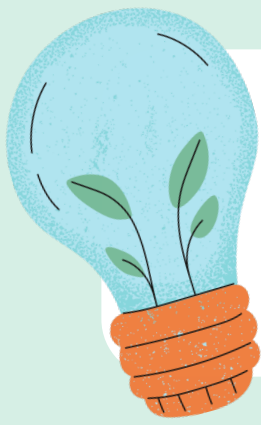
Math

News from 5th Grade

There is a lot of learning happening in 5th Grade!

History

The 5th Graders have been digging into the U.S. Civil War. We've discussed the impact that slavery had to cause the war, and all the efforts made by President Lincoln to abolish it in the 13th Amendment. We also discussed the need for additional freedoms found in the 14th and 15th Amendments.

There was some hands-on history as well as the students were able to hold some original Minie ball bullets from the 1800s and see an original soldier's kit of writing tablet, prayer and hymn book, and weapon repair kit from the actual Civil War!



Math

In 5th grade math we are currently working on multiplying and dividing fractions. We are also reviewing for the AASA practice test. We have been also learning about volume, and geometry.

AASA TEST PREP

All the 5th Grade teachers were hard at work in March preparing students for the AASA testing. In Science, Ms. Vail worked through a 5-paragraph essay on the Solar System, while Mr. Meihak provided the documents to examine to correctly perform in-text citations. Lastly, Mr. Besonen worked through the AASA practice writing prompt and score them using the AASA rubric. Each content-area teacher also focused working through their specific practice test.

This group of 5th Graders has some amazing talents and abilities. All the 5th Grade teachers are confident the students will give their best effort on the AASA tests to show their true potential!

We had such a great month in ELA! Students were so busy preparing for our AASA writing and reading tests. Students wrote an essay on "values and beliefs," and were able to complement that essay with another essay about food in space. Our students have the tools necessary to take on the state tests and take these skills with them to the next grade.
